

### Introduction

This month, you are going to get a front row seat to the inner life of a family from over 1,900 years ago! This family is the church in the city of Corinth. 1 & 2 Corinthians are letters written from the Apostle Paul to the church that lived in Corinth. In these two letters, Paul offers correction for sin, sets a clear expectation for how the church is supposed to worship God, and encourages them to walk in love and obedience to God.

The great news is that these letters were written for **you** just as much as it was for the church in Corinth! In Romans 14:5, God says, "For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope." This means that whatever is written in the Bible is meant for Christians across all of time...including you! As you read this month, remember that each word was meant to encourage and teach you just as it was written to teach and encourage the church 1,900 years ago!

**As you go through the reading each day, answer the following questions.** What did this passage teach you about God? What did it teach you about humanity? Did you see the gospel in this passage? Were there any commands given for how you should live? What is something new you learned through this passage?

### Memory Challenge

**Question:** What do we believe about the Holy Spirit?

**Answer:** That he is God, coeternal with the Father and the Son, and that God grants him irrevocably to all who believe.

**Passage:** "And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you." John 14:16-17

### Weekly Assignment

Each week, come up with one question that you have from that week's reading. Once you have written down that question, go and ask it to a parent, grandparent, small group leader, or any other trustworthy adult in your life.
