

Introduction

“The person and deity of Jesus is absolutely crucial to our faith as Christians. Without Him, we have no hope and no foundation for our beliefs. The Gospels, gives us a great picture of Jesus’ life on earth, but that’s not the only place in the Bible where we can read about Him. Jesus is evident throughout all of Scripture and is the main character of the gospel narrative.

This month, we will be reading through the books of Hebrews and James. Hebrews is a letter written to Jewish Christians, meant to deepen their trust in Jesus, despite persecution. The author explains that Jesus is greatest revelation of God and therefore He is worthy of their full trust and devotion. James was most likely written by Jesus’ brother and highlights that faith is more than just believing the correct theology, but it also involves following the greatest commandment: to love God with all your being and to love others.
