

## Introduction

God used Isaiah to communicate His promises to His people. Throughout the book of Isaiah, you will see God choose Isaiah to be His messenger and prophesy about Israel's consequences, God's blessings, the end times, and Jesus. God has kept every promise He has made to His people and remains faithful to His promises today. In James, we are given clear instructions to be faithful, honest, and to follow Christ's example of living a faithful and trustworthy life. God calls us to be faithful in our speech and actions, but there is nothing He calls us to that He has not already done. We must be honest and hold fast to the hope that He has called us to, for He who promised is faithful.

**As you read these stories each day, meditate on these questions.** What did God promise? How should the audience respond? What would it be like if the promises that you read were for you? Are they for you or specifically for Israel?
