

What is D6?

D6 is designed to offer guided time in the Bible 6 days a week and to develop a habit of learning from God's Word daily. If you miss a day, don't give up, just jump back in the next day! Each month your student finishes the D6 devotional, they will get a \$10 credit toward a Magnify event.

The name D6 comes from Deuteronomy 6:6-9 which is the passage that we look to in order to encourage our daily habit of reading God's Word.

"And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates." -Deuteronomy 6:6-9

To complete the D6

Your student can either print the pages and sign them when complete, or take a screenshot and sign the pages digitally when complete.

To submit the D6

Enter email address (HAS to be the same email every time), answer question, then click "Send Login Link". This will send you an email with a link. Follow the link, and then select D6 Kids. You can then click on your child's name or enter a new child, and choose to submit a new D6. All D6 submissions and redemptions will be kept under each child's name.

To redeem the D6

Follow the above login instructions, select the checkbox for each month you wish to redeem, then select which event you are redeeming for. Click "Redeem selected D6's for discount". You will then be sent an email with a discount code to enter on the chosen event registration. For example, the code will include D6x(# of D6's redeemed)
