

Introduction

This month, we will read about the Church. The Church, in the larger sense of the word, is everyone who has given their life to Christ. What we experience on a Sunday morning is known as the meeting of a local church; it's not a building, time, or activity, the church is the people. Many of the New Testament books were written to churches, and they give clear instructions on how the local church should function. It answers questions like: Who should be in charge? What do we do when we meet? What should we do in the community? And many more. The most important thing to know is that the Church belongs to Jesus; He is the one in charge. He tells us how to worship Him, how to become more like Him, and how to serve people in the context of the church. It is our job to know and live out the commands from His Word for His church. He does not leave it up to us to do that on our own. He empowers us to live out His commands through the Holy Spirit.

As you go through the reading each day, write down your answer to these questions: What did this passage teach you about God? What did it teach you about humanity? Did you see the gospel in this passage? Were there any commands given for how you should live? What is something new you learned through this passage?
