

Introduction

This month, you will read 1 Chronicles **AND** 2 Chronicles. The word “chronicle” might feel familiar if you have ever read “*The Chronicles of Narnia*” (you know, the one with Aslan the lion), or maybe it seems like someone just misspelled “Corinthians,” which is the book you read last month. To help you out, here is a short definition: **A chronicle is a written record of important historical events.** I know...more history...don’t you do enough of that in school? Don’t worry! 1 & 2 Chronicles bring you into **exciting, adventurous, battle-filled, and surprising** events. This includes the death of King Saul, King David’s empire, a kingdom divided, God’s people being captured, and the hope of God’s kingdom being rebuilt.

You are reading all of these exciting events as a middle schooler, so what does battle and the rise and fall of kingdoms have to do with you? In these books of the Bible, God gives us a clear picture of the importance of following Him, what happens to those who are disobedient, and most importantly, **we get to see how God protected His people and the line of David so that Jesus Christ could be born and save us from our sins!**

As you read each day, reflect on these questions. What did this passage teach you about God? What did it teach you about humanity? Did you see God protecting His people in this passage? Were there any commands given for how you should live? What is something new you learned through this passage?

Memory Challenge

Question: How does the Holy Spirit help us?

Answer: The Holy Spirit convicts us of our sin, and he enables us to pray and to understand God’s Word.

Passage: “And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication.”
